SACRAMENTS

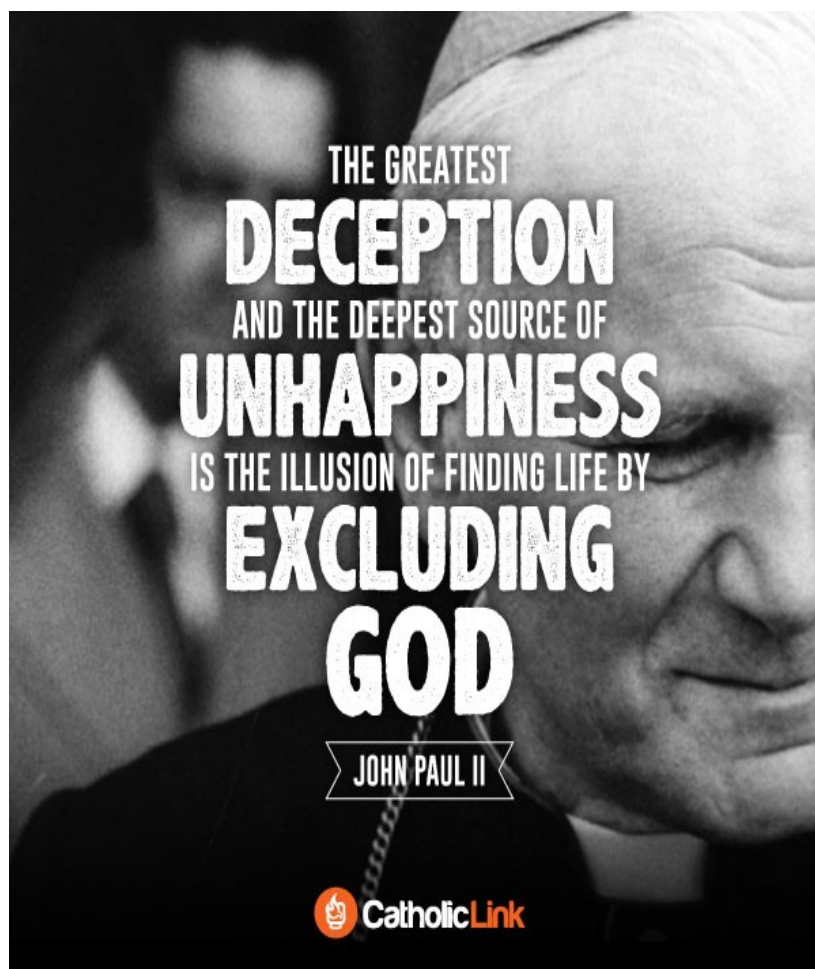
BAPTISM & CHRISMATIONS: Preparation is required. We encourage this to begin at least one month before the Baptism.

Current ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Maronite Church commemorates the temptation of Jesus in the wilderness on the fortieth day of Maronite Lent (it has its own Liturgy). That falls on the Friday before Hosanna Sunday (Palm Sunday for Roman Catholics). From Cana Sunday to temptation Friday in the week of Bartimaeus the Blind we get exactly 40 days. The next day we enter Passion Week with Lazarus Saturday, which is really its own Liturgical period and separate from the 40 days.

PARISH REGISTRATION. Membership is a condition for the reception of the sacraments of baptism, reconciliation, first Eucharist, confirmation and marriage. Registration is also required before the parish can issue a sponsorship certificate for those asked to be sacramental sponsors. You must be a registered, contributing member for at least three months before a certificate is provided or MACS voucher is approved. Or visit our website: <http://ststephenmaronite.org/about-us/>

BAPTISM & CHRISMATION. Baptism in the Maronite Rite is always accompanied by Chrismation (Confirmation). Both Sacraments are given by a priest, and always in the same ceremony. Preparation to receive the Sacraments of Baptism and Chrismation is required. We encourage this to happen before the birth of your child. THE MYSTERY OF CROWNING (MARRIAGE) Couples must contact the pastor at least six months prior to the desired date of the wedding. To initiate the marriage preparation process or if you have questions for weddings taking place at St. Stephen, contact Father Tony at 704-543-7677 x 1043.

HOLY ORDERS. The Maronite tradition attributes many characteristics and roles to the Order of Priesthood. Two of the more prominent ones are the roles of mediator and steward. The priest has been given the keys to the treasure of the Kingdom so that he might distribute its riches to those who have need of it. To discern a vocation of commitment to priesthood or religious life, please speak with the pastor.
